

Dear Campers,

We are writing to let you know that we have received your registration. We are excited to have you enrolled in our summer camp. We feel like this will be our best camp ever. I have listed below a number of questions and answers that will inform you about the procedures of camp. If you have any questions that are not answered by this, please contact us and we can help you.

When is my balance due and how do I pay it?

**All balances are due at check-in.** We can accept cash, checks, or money orders at the time of check-in.

Where is camp held?

**All camp activities and instruction are held at Camp Tontozona.** The camp is located at AZ-260 & Camp Tontozona Rd in Payson, AZ. Maps are attached to this email and can be accessed at our website: [www.skyathletics.com](http://www.skyathletics.com).

Where do I check-in?

**Check-in will be held at Camp Tontozona from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Sunday June 12th.** All remaining balances will be due at check-in. **Please print and sign the informed consent and release form at the end of this letter and bring with you to check-in.**

Where and when do I check-out?

Dormitories and cabins will be checked for cleanliness and damage before the competitions Thursday morning. Campers will check out of rooms after competitions. Each camper will compete in an informal competition **Thursday June 16th** in the morning, starting at 9:15 a.m. Parents and family are welcome and encouraged to come watch these competitions. Concessions and a BBQ will be on-site. **All competitions will conclude by 12:30 and campers will be free to go at that time.**

What are the accommodations?

Campers will be staying in dorms and cabins at Camp Tontozona. Boys and Girls will be housed in separate areas. Campers will have 24-hour supervision by counselors and staff. There will be mandatory lights out and bed checks at 10:30 pm each evening. Campers will eat three meals a day at the Camp Tontozona Cafeteria. All activity sessions will be held on site at Camp Tontozona. Campers will be responsible, and billed for any and all damage to the Camp Tontozona facilities.

What do I need to bring?

Campers will need to bring the following items: workout clothes, running shoes, spikes, hat, sunscreen, sleeping bag and/or sheets and blankets, pillow, toiletries, and a water bottle. We caution campers from bringing valuables to camp.

***Kiss the Sky Camps will provide poles for campers to use.***

Camp Mom

We will have a camp Mom at camp. We have a mother on staff that will be available to all campers for sickness, stress, and personal issues.

Phones

There is **NO cell phone coverage** at Camp Tontozona. We encourage campers to leave phones at home or check them in to staff for safekeeping. There is a phone on site that is available for emergency use only. ***Emergency calls may be made to 602 821-3771. We will be checking messages on this number twice daily.***

#### Directions

Please be aware of photo radar on AZ-260.

#### **From Phoenix:**

- Take Highway 87
- Turn Right at Highway 260
- Take Highway 260 past Kohl's Ranch (about 17 miles)
- Turn Right at Camp Tontozona Road

#### **From Las Vegas:**

- Take US-93 to I-40 East
- Take I-17 exit towards Phoenix
- Take AZ-260 toward Cottonwood/Payson/AZ-89A
- Turn Right at AZ-260/AZ-87
- At the traffic circle, take the 1st exit onto AZ-260/AZ-87/N Beeline Highway
- Turn Left at E AZ-260
- Turn Right at Camp Tontozona Road

#### **From Albuquerque:**

- Take I-40 West toward Gallup
- Take I-40 Bus Loop/AZ-77 toward Heber/Show Low
- Turn Right at AZ-377 Heber Rd
- Turn Right at AZ-277
- Turn Right at AZ-260
- Turn Right at Camp Tontozona Road

#### Car-pooling

If you are in need of a ride, or have a ride to give, **please contact us by Monday June 7th** to make the necessary arrangements. You can call 602 821-3771 for specific details at any time.

#### Airport Pick-up

If you are flying into Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport and need to be picked up and transported to camp, **we will need your itinerary and flight information by Monday, June 6<sup>th</sup>** to make the necessary arrangements. If you have yet to make flight arrangements, it is best to have arrival into Phoenix between 9:00 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. on June 12th, and between 3:30 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on June 16th.
